Day 1

This practice has been passed down through generations, contributing to Karnataka's prominence as a leading producer of silk in India.
- Interact with Locals of Kokarebellur: Engage with the people of Kokarebellur, known for their dedication to protecting the village's unique bird population, particularly migratory birds. Their respect for nature and wildlife exemplifies human-animal coexistence.
- Meet the Bird Man of Kokarebellur: Learn about the local champions of conservation, known as the 'Bird Man of Kokarebellur,' who dedicate their lives to protecting and nurturing the bird population while educating others about the importance of preserving their habitat.
- Bird Photography: Enjoy bird photography opportunities, capturing painted storks, spot-billed pelicans, and other migratory species in their natural habitat, especially during nesting and breeding seasons.
- Local Lunch: Savor a traditional meal featuring Ragi Mudde, a staple dish in Karnataka.
